- D. Approval of Meeting Minutes was tabled until minutes were provided. Motion by Powers-Taylor support by Conant. All in favor. Motion passed.

5. Unfinished Business:

- A. Motion by Powers-Taylor supported by Conant to schedule a special meeting on Tuesday, February 28, 2023 at 7:00 pm to discuss the contract the SDDA has with American Ramp Company. At this meeting all questions and concerns about the pump track will be dealt with including storm drain connection, dry well, fencing, landscaping. All in favor. Motion passed.
