Dollars per bleacher assembly for assembling each aluminum bleacher, which are shipped as unassembled kits. (Note need to consider delivery and arrangements for assembly with currying time of Cement Slab.)







Hi again: Justin and I wanted to touch base on a few things we had planned to mention when you stopped by last week — again, I'm so sorry I wasn't able to be here for your visit!

- 1. Pump track maintenance questions: As Justin takes daily spins around the pump track, he's noticing signs of aging that will affect the riding experience and would probably be better/cheaper to nip in the bud and we're assuming you may already be working with Velosolutions on regular maintanance. Justin said there's one crack in particular that he's watched get bigger in just the past few weeks. Is there anything we can do to help with your regular maintance process? Subject: Fire Hydrant replacements within the TIFD.

At the request of the Village Manger and the Villages Department of Public Works new supervisor to provide \$49,283.12 in funding to replace 8 each fire hydrants within the TIFD. The SDDA board at the urging of the SDDA chair approved said purchase on August 04,2025 at their regular scheduled SDDA meeting for several reason 1. The replacement of the defective fire hydrants within the TIFD has been an ongoing pet project of the SDDA Chair. 2. The new DPW Supervisor has the knowledge and skill to replace the fire hydrants, which is a new and very welcome skill. 3. The replacement of the fire hydrants will provide added fire protection and insurance on homes will be able to continue receiving a reduction in insurance premiums. 4. The lead time for ordering and receiving the fire hydrants is many months. 5. The replacement of fire hydrants is a priority of the Villages utilities committee. 6. The Village council had already approved the SDDA 2024 plan amendment which authorized up to \$50,000 a year for fire hydrant repairs / replacement. 7. The SDDA Village Council had already approved the SDDA, 2025-2026 budget which authorized the expenditure of \$25,000 for replacement of 2 hydrants and only would require village council approval to amend the SDDA 2025/2026 budget by increasing the line item for the fire hydrants from \$25,000 to \$50,000. 8. The SDDA currently has available around \$400,000 in our bank account.

I take full responsibility for not obtaining village council approval prior to authorizing the Village Mangaer to order the 8 fire hydrants. I just plain forgot to do that step.
